

Hall of Fame

Three of the four criteria must be met in order to be considered for the Hall of Fame. Those criteria are:

- Outstanding contribution leading to enhancement of the league, (running tournaments, bringing in new players, conduct, sportsmanship, new ideas to expand/improve league, etc)
- Twenty years membership in the league,
- Captain/Co-Captain of a team or a league officer for five or more years,
- three or more tournament wins (1st, 2nd, or 3rd) in the singles or doubles tournament competition.
