

HALL OF FAME

In 1994, the Queen City Pool League's Board of Directors designated a Hall of Fame committee to recognize and honor past and present participants of the league. The committee, made up of: Norm Couturier, Chairman, Armand Chaput, Mike Ploss, Dick Paquin and Roger Lessard developed criteria for induction into the Hall of Fame. In order to be approved for entry, a Queen City Pool League member was required to meet three (3) of the following four (4) criteria:

- Outstanding contribution leading to enhancement of the league;
- Twenty (20) years membership in the league;
- Captain of a team or a league officer for five (5) years or more;
- Three (3) or more tournament wins (1st, 2nd or 3rd) in the State Singles or State Doubles competition.

On the basis of the criteria listed above, the following inductees received, from the league's officers, a Queen City Pool League Hall of Fame lapel pin as well as the professionally created and printed Hall of Fame certificate shown below:
